
Social Security Office

- For the purpose of obtaining a driver's license, we will go to the Social Security Office to receive a signed "Denial" letter. If your spouse also intends to receive a driver's license they must also come with us to the Social Security office for a denial letter.
- Documents to bring:
 - Passport
 - I-94
 - I-20
 - Identification Letter from Graduate Admissions/CIFS

New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission for License

- Documents to bring:
 - Foreign Passport, including the I-94 form & I-20 form
 - Rutgers photo ID
 - Social Security denial letter (this is REQUIRED even though it is not considered 1-point)
 - Bank Card or Bank Statement (while some foreign bank cards are accepted, not all of them are)
 - Health Insurance card and paperwork confirming Health Insurance
 - Letter from housing office (this confirms proof of address)
 - Marriage Certificate/License for spouse in English Translation
 - Korean Driver's License in English Translation


- Trip to the School District to get your children registered for school
