

Board Meeting Minutes

Approval of Minutes

- The minutes from the meeting of March 16, 2015 were distributed.
- YirguW made a motion to approve the minutes. DavidG seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

- JimZ has been in contact with the School. Fran Loeser provided JimZ and YirguW with a report, which was distributed.
- The Association's projected balance for FY15 is \$45,914.48.
- AoY generated about \$22,000; the gift assessment fee was about \$1,700; the fellowship award represented the final expense.
- YirguW asked about replenishing the BSAA operating expense budget.
- HillaryB said that we could work with MeeraA to ensure that FY15 income be allocated both to scholarship and operating expenses.

Regional Alumni Group Updates

Washington, D.C. Group

- HillaryB recalled that the April D.C. PoP Topic was "Conflict Resolution Locally & Globally."
- The location was be the GAO, 441 G St NW, Washington, DC 20548.
- About 30 attendees were present; one student made the trip from New Brunswick.
- The event was very well received; five alums from GAO were pleased to host the event.
- The venue did represent a bit of a challenge, due to its security procedures.

APA Seattle Alumni Gathering

- The School hosted an alumni gathering at the April APA conference.
- This was one of the largest attendance APA conferences ever, with about 6,700 attendees.
- About 45 alums attended the gathering, which was a larger than expected headcount.
- Both Connie and Dean Hughes were able to attend.
- The event was still going strong even an hour past its published end time. HillaryB stated that the event was a very strong connector back to the School.

- JimZ asked about Commencement. EJB Graduate commencement is being held on May 16.
